New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.3
Floating Mooring Bitts

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that five (5) floating mooring bitts are out of service in the primary 110-ft x 1,200-ft river lock chamber at New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.3. The bitts missing are located at the 100-ft, 450-ft, 750-ft, and 1,200-ft mark on River Wall, in addition to the 1,200-ft mark on the Middle wall.
2. New floating mooring bitts are scheduled to be installed by the Pittsburgh Repair Fleet sometime next spring. It is anticipated that all floating mooring bitts will be operational by April 10, 2015.
3. Mariners are encouraged to follow the instructions of lock personnel and to use caution while navigating through the primary lock chamber.
