Shield Wire Replacement Monongahela River, Mile 30

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that Sargent Electric, contractor for Duquesne Light Company will be replacing the overhead shield wire crossing the Monongahela River, at the West Penn Power/First Energy-Mitchell Power Station, approximate Mile 30, located in Forward Township, Allegheny County and New Eagle, Washington County, Pennsylvania.
2. The shield wire replacement will consist of attaching the new shield wire to the old shield wire, and pulling it across the river. There will be no work within the Monongahela River resulting in no delay or impact to navigation. Upon observation of an approaching vessel, the work will temporarily halt to let vessels pass through the work area
3. The work will begin on April 21, 2014 and be completed April 25, 2014. Work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
4. Radio marine channels will not be monitored during the replacement project.
5. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
