Hannibal Locks and Dams, Ohio River, Mile 126.4
Closure of the 110-ft x 1,200-ft Primary Lock Chamber

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that a contractor for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be testing and commissioning the new interlock control system at Hannibal Lock and Dam, Ohio River.
2. **The 110-ft x 1,200-ft Primary Lock Chamber at Hannibal Lock and Dam will be closed to all navigation on Tuesday June 3, 2014.** The outage is expected to last eight (8) hours with the potential of lasting up to fourteen (14) hours. Moderate to major delays to navigation traffic can be expected.
3. **No multi-cut lockages will be permitted unless industry is willing to implement a voluntary self-help program.**
4. Mariners are encouraged to monitor **Channel 13** on their marine radios during this closure. Using that channel, lock personnel will notify the mariners when the chamber is back in service.
5. Navigators are requested to use caution when entering or leaving the primary lock chamber to prevent a complete shutdown of navigation.
